## PROGRESS SINCE REVOLUTION

- Infant mortality dropped since 70s, and literacy rate has surged from 37% to 87%
- ¾ of population lives in urban areas, though some lack jobs/housing/entertainment
- Electricity, water, and internet available through the country

## **IRAN IN CRISIS:**

- Drug addiction high rate of opium use in the world!
- Women's rights protests throughout the country for several months
- GNI/cap in PPP \$15,760. Government ended subsidies on food and medicine imports last May, causing steep inflation (~52%) and slow growth (2.9%)
